Planning Committee

Minutes of a meeting of Avebury Parish Council's Planning Committee held on 12 July 2022 at Vine Cottage and 25 Trusloe Cottages to consider the planning applications below.

- 1) Apologies for absence: Councillors Ben Butler, Donna Byatt, Mike Daniel, Maggie Lewis, Lynzey Paradise, and Bob Parker.
- 2) Declarations of interest: none was declared.
- 3) To answer questions from members of the public: there were no members of the public present.
- 4) To consider the planning applications listed below:
 - a) **Householder Planning Permission for a detached store and sun room at Vine Cottages, South Street, Avebury Trusloe SN8 1QX. Ref: PL/2022/04390**
Members explored the site under the supervision of the applicants and, after discussion, decided to support the application and **it was so resolved**, being proposed by Cllr Service, seconded by Cllr Bedford, and carried unanimously. The Chair thanked the applicants for allowing the committee to visit the site.
 - b) **Householder Planning Permission for a single storey rear extension at 25 Trusloe Cottages, Avebury Trusloe SN8 1QZ. Ref: PL/2022/04638**
Members explored the site under the supervision of the applicant and, after discussion, decided to support the application and **it was so resolved**, being proposed by Cllr Bedford, seconded by Cllr Service, and carried unanimously. The Chair thanked the applicant for allowing the committee to visit the site.
 - c) **Consent under Tree Preservations Order for A1 Walnut (Jugulars Regia) (T1 of TPO E/316) At North Rutlands, Swindon Road, Avebury SN8 1RH. Ref: PL/2022/05093. Remove 1x lower limb overhanging drive. Pictures attached AR/01.** This branch has historically been damaged by delivery lorries. Due to this damage, the branch is growing at a right angle, looking very unnatural. It also limits access to the property with the risk of further damage to the entire tree if caught again.

Members examined photographs of the tree in question and, after discussion, decided to support the application and **it was so resolved**, being proposed by Cllr Service, seconded by Cllr Bedford, and carried unanimously.
