

## Avebury Parish Council: Information for precept for 2017/18

### Reserve fund

The Parish Council has a reserve of money brought forward from previous years. This enables us to deal with fluctuations in our cash flow, provide grants or matched funding for local projects, pay for any professional advice that might become necessary, meet contingencies etc.

The following table shows the reserve on 31 March each year for the past 16 years and the precept received during the following 12 months. In 2009 and 2010, the reserve fund met some of the costs of improvements to the Trusloe playground. Since then the reserves have increased, due to underspending on various items including Liz's salary during her maternity leaves.

\* £11,000 is the current precept figure.

By next March, our reserves are likely to fall by £8,726 if we make transfers of: £500 for Avebury Day, £5,000 for transport projects, £1,663 for APC's share of the pavilion mains water scheme, and £1,563 to meet the 2016/17 deficit.

National guidance states that our reserves should not be more than about 100% of our precept.
