Site re-opening plans

The following elements of our offer are open:

Facilities

- Main visitor car park, daily 10am-5pm
- Welcome trailer in car park, daily 11am-4pm (subject to staff availability)
- High Street toilets, daily 10.30am-5pm
- Farmyard toilets, daily 10.00am-5.30pm

Visitor offer

- Visitor reception in the Barn, daily 10am-5pm
- Avebury Manor Garden, daily 11am-5pm; online booking + walk-ups (subject to capacity); tickets £5, free for Avebury residents

Commercial

- Circles Restaurant takeaway and outdoors seating, daily 10.30am-4.30pm
- Coach House Café, school holidays and weekends only, variable opening hours
- NT Shop, daily 10am-5.30pm
- Cobblestones second-hand bookshop, Thursdays-Mondays 11am-4pm (subject to volunteer availability)

In w/c 17 May the following elements of our offer will re-open (subject to Gov/NT guidance):

- Alexander Keiller Museum, Stables Gallery only, daily 10am-5pm; walk-up bookings; tickets £5, free for Avebury residents
- Avebury Manor, guided tours only, Fr – Sun 11am, 1pm, 3pm; walk-up bookings; tickets £5, free for Avebury residents
- Guided henge tours, days and times tbc
- Circles Restaurant indoors seating (tbc), daily 10.30am-4.30pm

Accessibility improvements

We are improving our offer for people with accessibility needs, to ensure everyone can visit and enjoy Avebury; this includes purchasing a countryside tramper (electric buggy-style vehicle) and producing video material of the new manor tour, for people with mobility issues or visual or hearing impairments.
