Dear Residents,

I would like to thank all of you that took the time to return the anti-social behaviour survey that I posted to all residents of Avebury Trusloe some weeks ago now.

The main issue that was raised in the survey was ASB and drug activity in and around the caravan parked on the Nursery. Notice was given to the occupant by Wiltshire Police and Wiltshire Council. The caravan was removed by the occupant without the need for enforcement and a vehicle left behind has been removed by the council.

I will be talking with Aster, the parish council, Wiltshire Council and hopefully the other landowner in the coming months to try to find a solution to the open access to the Nursery in an effort to avoid another issue with unwanted residents on the site. .

I have forwarded replies to the anti-social behaviour survey to Aster housing where specific issues in relation to housing/residents have been raised.

I will be looking into any other concerns raised that Wiltshire Police can assist with.

I urge you to report any issues involving your neighbours to the Aster housing officer for the area who will be able to provide you with support and advice.
