

**THE COMMUNITY EXHIBITION SPACE IN THE CHAPEL, GREEN STREET, AVEBURY:**  
**USING THE SPACE IN THE BEST POSSIBLE WAY**

Thinking about the internal space of the chapel, there seem to be the following opportunities. It would be good to know now which are of interest to you. Please answer as many of the questions below as you can. 'Yes' or 'no' will often suffice. Please make suggestions, too; there is a box at the end for these. Thank you very much indeed for your help.

**PANELS**

There are 32 panel sites of varying sizes on extant furnishings set at different heights from the ground on which you could display information, photographs, maps, etc.

- There are 8 at head height and 8 at knee height (ideal for children?) on the external faces of the office (on one side) and the kitchenette (on the other side)
- There are 4 on the south-facing angles of the office and kitchenette (2 at knee height and 2 at head height).
- There are 12 sites available at knee height on the doors beneath the counters (on either side and to the south of the office and kitchenette).

We could make 10 (being 8 + 2 as below) head height panel sites available as permanent or semi-permanent displays.

- The 8 panel sites on the external faces of the office and the kitchenette measure 53,5 x 94,5cm.
- The 2 panel sites set at an angle are 78 x 85cm.

We might be able to fund a blank panel board for you to use if you do not have your own.

The 8 + 2 panel sites at knee height may be more difficult to use but they are there for anybody wanting them.

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## PULL-UP DISPLAYS

You may want to use a pull up display.

## NOTICE BOARDS

You might prefer to put printed material on a free-standing board.

## POSTERS

There is a good deal of wall space.

<i>And how many?</i>	

## HORIZONTAL SURFACES

Would you like to use a table or cabinet to display material? It may not be straightforward to accommodate more than a few tables or cabinets but we ought to be able to find space for some.

<i>Do you want to have space for a table or display cabinet?</i>	
<i>If so, what are its measurements?</i>	

## OBJECTS

There is some floor space though perhaps not as much as first appears given that visitors need to move around safely. It would nevertheless be good to have a piece of relevant farm equipment (for example) or a landscape model (in a transparent case) or similar. An artefact whose use could be demonstrated by a skilled user would also be an asset. In addition you might be able to suspend an object from one of the beams.

## PROJECTION

The chapel has a projector and a screen that pulls down in the transept (or whatever it is in a chapel). It is possible for all but the unusually tall to walk from one part of the building to the other without disturbing the screen. We could display PowerPoint slides/video on it.

It is also possible (as we saw at our last meeting) to project at an angle from a point near the pulpit. Indeed we could project onto both walls (and centrally) simultaneously or in sequence.

## AUDIO

It was suggested that we could have continuous or on demand background sounds of e.g. local wildlife.
