Options

- Parking at West Kennett Farm
- Allocate bays for permit holders
- Reduce number/geography for permits
- Supervise/monitor High Street car park (volunteers?)
- ANPR for High Street car park
- Asking volunteers to park in the Main Visitor car park
- Arranging for local Cadet groups to assist with parking during busy periods
- Create a new car park along the 49 bus route
- More promotion for discount when visitors use public transport
- Provision for resident's larger vehicles in a discrete location
- Signposting on the Avebury website to bus routes and bus company websites
- Shuttle bus from a new car park further away
- More public transport links between Avebury and Stonehenge
- Facility for taking credit card payments in the Main Visitor car park
- Ask Wiltshire Council to look at the Sanctuary car park
- Ask Wiltshire Council to look into a resident's on road parking scheme with enforcement
