Worried about getting food in or a prescription renewed?

Avebury's community shop is ready to help with your shopping

The shop has a well-established home-delivery service. Simply **telephone the shop on 539200** to place your order.

The shop will pick your order into a box, work out the cost, and a shop manager will call you back when it is ready and to take your payment using bank or credit card over the phone. They will also tell you when it is going to be delivered to your door by a member of the community.

We prefer payments over the phone by bank or credit card as it is better not to pass cash between us; we want to minimise the risk of virus transfer. However we will accept cash on delivery if you tell us and this will allow us to have change available.

Prescription medicines collection

If you are in self-isolation because of the virus and have no-one able to pick up a prescription from the GP, please **telephone Rev Maria Shepherdson (539643)**, who will make arrangements for it to be collected for you.

What happens next?

We are listening to advice from Public Health England and Wiltshire Council and stand ready to help all who need it in our community as circumstances evolve.
